This fully funded course provides a fantastic opportunity for individuals wanting to pursue a career in Makeup. Completed learners can progress onto NVQ3 Theatrical, Photographic & Media Makeup, which is required to work as a Professional Makeup Artiste.

On this course you will study:



Facial Therapy

- ü **Fact:** Skin provides the blank canvas for makeup, therefore the maintenance of good skin is vital to the finished professional makeup.
- ü **Treatment Techniques:** Skin Analysis, Cleansing, Exfoliating, Steaming, Mask Therapy, Facial Massage, Comedone and Whitehead extraction, Toning and Moisturising.



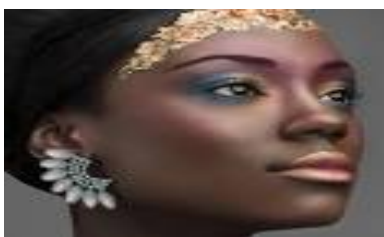
Eye Treatments

- ü **Treatment Techniques:** Shaping and Tinting Eyebrows, Tinting Eyelashes, Applying both Strip and Individual Flair Lashes. (Please note: *Eyelash Perming for root lift, and permanent eyelash extensions can be studied as a workshop option at an additional cost*)



Make-up Application

- ü **Design Looks:** Day Makeup, Evening Makeup, Special Event Makeup, Bridal Makeup, Photographic Makeup, Fantasy Makeup, Mood board, and Face Designs.



Provide Makeup Application advice

- ü **Creativity:** Instruct a client on the application of makeup to enhance their personal appearance and confidence.



Camouflage Make-up

- ü **Fact:** The application of Camouflage makeup to cover up Imperfections, Birth Marks, Tattoos, as well as Contouring the face to enhance Facial features.



Additional units will include

- ü **Core units:** Health & safety, Services & Products, Effectiveness at work and Setting up a Mobile Makeup business. Designed to enhance not only your employability, but to develop the skills required for sustainable employment.

Course Information:

Professional Internationally recognised **VTCT NVQ2 in Makeup** qualification.

This is a **12 week programme, 2 days per week**. The study days are:

- ü Wednesday 10am – 5pm
- ü Thursday 10am – 5pm
- ü With programmed specialist workshops available on a Friday dates to be confirmed

Who can apply?

If you are aged **19** plus (there is no upper age limit on this course offer) funding is available. All learners will be required to pay the VTCT registration fee, and you will also need to purchase a TLT Uniform and Kit.
